**Youth Impact:**

The Leadership Training Course (LTC) graduates officially transitioned from students to mentors this past July, turning La Union into a massive classroom for Christ.

Eighteen young leaders took the lead, successfully running a Vacation Bible Study for 50 children and a high-energy leadership seminar for 40 of their peers. They didn't just stay in the halls; they hit the pavement for house-to-house evangelism, proving that the traditional "Kuya" and "Ate" (big brother/sister) role is the most powerful tool for discipleship. For this generation, the ultimate "trend" is personal transformation.

In December, the mission shifted to the "hustle" of Manila, targeting the nation’s most concentrated youth population. Over four intensive days, the team embraced the challenge of Campus Evangelism where feeding programs met spiritual hunger head-on - showing up for out-of-school youth in the city’s poorest areas, these leaders proved that the Gospel likes to meet poverty head on!

**Project Title:**

Darkness to Light: Philippines Outreach Projects

**Project Overview:**

Many young people in the Philippines still lack access to the gospel despite the country's large number of Christian churches. In response to this, YFCP is having two national outreach programs. This evangelistic outreach will also be very beneficial in looking for potential future openings of other YFC centers across the nation.

**Figures:**

A total of 18 young leaders have been successfully registered to participate in the Training, with the support of 10 dedicated staff members. A further 7 volunteers and staff went on an outreach in Manila, reaching out to about a hundred kids and youth from 2 different places received the gospel, including families.
